

**Platinum Service Award
Established in 2013**

The **Platinum Service Award** is the highest individual honor bestowed by the PRSA Western District. Its purpose is to recognize outstanding career achievements in furthering the practice of public relations. It has also been created to honor personal service to the Western District and any of the affiliated chapters within the Western District.

Eligibility: All current members in good standing of an affiliated chapter of the PRSA Western District, who have been members of a chapter for more than one year, are eligible for the award with two exceptions-- the current year's PRSA Western District Chair and all previous Platinum Service Award honorees are ineligible. Nominations are to be approved by each of the Western District's member chapters' Board of Directors before submission. Only one nomination will be accepted from each chapter.

Platinum Service Award criteria:

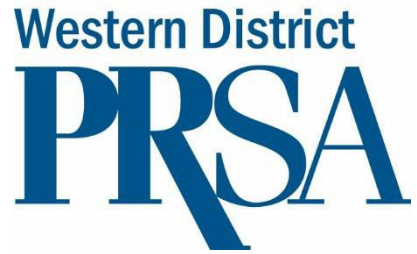
- Service to PRSA, particularly to the member chapter or the PRSA Western District, but may also include contributions to other chapters and PRSA National
- Perpetuates the highest standards and ethics of the profession in the practice of public relations
- Applications are good for three years.

The honoree will be presented the Platinum Service Award at the Western District Conference in Hawaii on Thursday, April 28, 2022. It is our hope that the honoree will be present to accept the award in person or will submit a video accepting the award for display at the conference.
